

# MULTIMEDIA-RELATED CAREER PROJECT

## Instruction Sheet

### STEP ONE

Using the Occupational Outlook website (<http://stats.bls.gov/search/oooh.asp?ct=OOH>), answer the following questions about a multimedia-related career of your choice:

1. Describe the nature of the work.
2. Describe the working conditions.
3. Identify how many people were employed in 2002.
4. Describe the training and education required.
5. Describe the job outlook for your chosen career in comparison with other multimedia-related jobs.
6. Describe the earnings. Specifically include information about the salary paid at the different levels within the career researched (ie. Staff level, senior level, freelance, etc). Also, provide information on the lowest, highest, and median earnings for the career field of your choice.

### STEP TWO

Using MS Word, you will need to type your responses in the form of a report. Be sure to save your report as **Multimedia Career**. You will print the project upon completion.
